**TYPICAL FUNCTIONS:**

- Performs tests and inspections of fuel dispensers to assure accurate measurement.
- Performs field checks of motor fuels for octane rating and obtains samples for laboratory analysis.
- Inspects underground fuel storage tanks to ensure integrity, including adequate corrosion protection and compliance with upgrade requirements.
- Verifies that the Commission has approved all antifreeze offered for sale.
- Prepares periodic reports of station inspections; prepares complaint investigation reports and special reports.
- Counsels station operators concerning interpretation of Commission rules and recommends plans to correct deficiencies.
- Issues Notices of Violation and enforces Commission Orders.
- Serves as liaison to multi-agency or government-industry environmental committees, speaking at civic and industry group meetings.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- Applicants must be willing and able to fulfill all job-related travel normally associated with this position.
- Repetitive lifting of fuel calibration cans weighing approximately 40 pounds is required
- Applicant may be required to reside within assigned work territory.
