**PRELIMINARY PROCEDURAL ORDER**

BY THE COMMISSION:

The Corporation Commission of the State of Oklahoma (the "Commission") being regularly in session and the undersigned Commissioners being present and participating, there comes on for consideration the Initial Screening Conference conducted on July 27, 2009, pursuant to Oklahoma Administrative Code ("OAC") 165:5-11-2.1 in the above-styled matter.

After hearing statements of counsel and being fully advised in the matter, the Commission finds this cause shall be referred to Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Maribeth D. Snapp to be heard on its merits and to make rulings on all procedural matters and motions, with an express recognition of the Commissioners' right to attend and participate in future hearings following the posting of proper notice.

The Commission further finds that the hearing on the merits and all procedural matters and motions shall be set for hearing before the ALJ in Courtroom 301.

The Commission further finds that a Procedural Order will issue at a later date addressing discovery and procedural matters, dates for hearing, dates for filing testimonies and responses thereto, any hearing briefs, and the submission of any proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law for potential use in the ALJ's Report and Recommendation.

The Commission suggests, based upon statements of counsel and independent considerations, that the Procedural Order also include Settlement Conference date(s) after the date for the filing of responsive testimonies but before the date for the filing of rebuttal testimonies, as well as the presentation of closing statements by counsel at the conclusion of any hearing on the merits or presentation of any agreed stipulation and settlement.


The Commission further finds that it is vested with jurisdiction over this cause pursuant to Article IX, Section 18 of the Oklahoma Constitution; Title 17, Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 151 *et set.*; 17 O.S. §§ 263-264; 17 O.S. §§ 281-285; OAC 165:45; and, OAC 165:70.

The Commission further finds that this Preliminary Procedural Order and the general provisions set forth herein shall be adopted by the Commission and adhered to by the parties until modified by a subsequent Commission order.


**ORDER**
