Today I received a notice of intent from the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company that they were going to apply for a rate increase on November 9, 2009. I find this very peculiar given the current economic environment. By all accepted standards of measurements, the Consumer Price Index has decreased this past year. Inflation has been **negative**! Energy prices have **decreased** this past year!

It seems to me that the requested increase from ONG is quite arrogant indeed – especially while the rest of us deal with our reduced and/or missing income in this economic environment...

It should NOT be approved and I encourage our commissioners/officials to deny any such rate increase. Let the economy heal before putting any more extra burden on the typical resident..
