## **MEDIA ADVISORY – NEW DEVELOPMENTS IN MEETING OKLAHOMA’S AND AMERICA’S ENERGY NEEDS**

**(Oklahoma City) The Oklahoma Wind Power Assessment Committee, charged by the Oklahoma legislature with investigating and recommending alternative energy sources and policies for the state, will present its final report Tuesday, September 27 at the Discovering Innovative Energy Solutions for Oklahoma's Future conference to be held at the National Center for Employee Development, 2701 E. Imhoff, Norman. The Committee is chaired by Corporation Commissioner Denise Bode. The Committee’s interim report, released earlier this year, is attached.**
