**ECONOMIC IMPACT AND ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFIT STATEMENT**

This Economic Impact and Environmental Benefit Statement is being prepared pursuant to 27A O.S. Section 1-1-206.

**I. ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED RULES**

The proposed rulemaking should have minimal or no adverse economic impact upon the affected owners and operators of petroleum storage tanks located in the state. In addition, the proposed rules should have minimal or no adverse economic impact on regulated entities.

**II. ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFIT OF THE PROPOSED RULES**

Revising the requirements for fuel inspection will coincide with the same rules as recently promulgated by the Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") regarding Statistical Inventory Reconciliation ("SIR"). These proposed rule changes will enhance owner/operator diligence and strengthen release detection and help protect human health, safety and the environment.
