ECONOMIC IMPACT AND ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFIT STATEMENT

This Economic Impact and Environmental Benefit Statement is being prepared pursuant to 27A O.S. Section 1-1-206.

I. ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED EMERGENCY RULES

The proposed emergency rulemaking should have no adverse economic impact upon the affected owners and operators of underground petroleum storage tanks located in the state. In addition, the proposed emergency rules should have no adverse economic impact on Commission licensed storage tank professionals.

II. ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFIT OF THE PROPOSED EMERGENCY RULES

Revising the requirements for underground storage tanks will coincide with the same rules as recently promulgated by the Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA"). These proposed emergency rule changes will enhance owner/operator diligence and strengthen release detection and help protect human health, safety and the environment.
