**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Transportation Division of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission ("Commission") recommends that the Commission amend the Motor Carriers, Private Carriers and Transportation Network Companies rules that are set forth in the Oklahoma Administrative Code ("OAC") 165:30.

The proposed changes to OAC 165:30 are as follows:

OAC 165:30-7-8 is revoked as the section is no longer necessary to Chapter 30.

OAC 165:30-7-9 is revoked as the section is no longer necessary to Chapter 30.

OAC 165:30-7-10 is revoked as the section is no longer necessary to Chapter 30.

OAC 165:30-12-1 is amended to clarify when Unified Carrier Registration fees may be refunded.

OAC 165:30-17-12 is amended to remove an erroneously included redundant term.

OAC 165:30-19-2 is amended to correct an erroneously included word.

OAC 165:30-19-4 is amended to clarify proof of vehicle ownership under the International Registration Plan.

OAC 165:30-19-13 is revoked as the section is no longer necessary to Chapter 30.

OAC 165:30-19-15 is amended to clarify the mileage requirements and eligibility for apportioned registration since the Full Reciprocity Plan has been implemented.

OAC 165:30-19-19 is amended to disclose the possibility of future processing fees for temporary trip permits or hunter permits.

OAC 165:30-21-12 is amended to clarify when a contempt citation may be issued for revoked International Fuel Tax Agreement licenses.

OAC 165:30-23-2 is added as a new permanent rule to require Motor License Agents to properly document their fees charged to taxpayers/registrants to ensure all fees are authorized by statute.

OAC 165:30-23-5 is amended to require that Motor License Agents service all types of International Registration Plans customers.

OAC 165:30-26-14 is amended to change the allowable time for compliance with written instructions from the Transportation Division.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the Commission has authority to initiate this permanent rulemaking pursuant to the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §§ 250 *et seq.*, 17 O.S. § 152, and Article IX, Section 18 of the Oklahoma Constitution.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that it is necessary to adopt permanent rules regarding Motor Carriers, Private Carriers and Transportation Network Companies. Upon adoption of the permanent rules proposed herein, by the Commission, the proposed rules shall be submitted to the Governor and the Oklahoma Legislature for approval as permanent rules.




