ECONOMIC IMPACT AND ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFIT STATEMENT

This Economic Impact and Environmental Benefit Statement is being prepared pursuant to 27A O.S. Section 1-1-206.

I. ECONOMIC IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED EMERGENCY RULE

The proposed emergency rulemaking should have no adverse economic impact upon the affected owners and operators of underground petroleum storage tanks located in the state. In addition, the proposed emergency rule should have no adverse economic impact on Commission licensed storage tank professionals.

II. ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFIT OF THE PROPOSED EMERGENCY RULE

Adding a procedural rule to compliment the recently promulgated administrative application for variance rule for tank closure in place will establish a method for administrative processing of applications. The procedural part of the rule was inadvertently omitted, thus not allowing the administrative process with a mechanism to be utilized. By including the administrative process into the rules of practice, the intent of the previous rule change will be realized.
