NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING COURT CLERK'S OFFICE - OKC

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Transportation Division of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission ("Commission") recommends that the Commission amend the Gas and Hazardous Liquid Pipeline Safety rules that are set forth in the Oklahoma Administrative Code ("OAC") 165:20.

The proposed changes to OAC 165:20 are as follows:

OAC 165:20-3-1 is amended to simplify current language in the rule for submitting reports each fiscal year, and to remove outdated language.

OAC 165:20-5-1 is revoked as the section is no longer necessary to Chapter 20.

OAC 165:20-5-3 is amended to make a grammatical change.

OAC 165:20-5-4 is amended to change the term "ownership" to "operator."

OAC 165:20-5-11 is amended to require that operators report incidents within one (1) hour, and to include the website address for filing damages online.

OAC 165:20-5-14 is amended to remove language which is outdated and no longer relevant.

OAC 165:20-5-15 is revoked as the section is no longer necessary to Chapter 20.

OAC 165:20-5-21 is amended to update the reference to the Code of Federal Regulations to the most recent version.

OAC 165:20-5-34 is revoked as the section is no longer necessary to Chapter 20.

OAC 165:20-5-41 is amended to update the references to the Oklahoma Underground Facilities Damage Prevention Act to the most recent version.

OAC 165:20-7-1 is amended to update the reference to the Code of Federal Regulations to the most recent version, and to include the website address for filing damages online.

OAC 165:20-7-3 is amended to update the references to the Oklahoma Underground Facilities Damage Prevention Act to the most recent version.

OAC 165:20-7-4 is amended to change the term "ownership" to "operator."

OAC 165:20-7-6 is amended to remove outdated language.

OAC 165:20-13-1 is amended to include reference to the Oklahoma Underground Facilities Damage Prevention Act.

OAC 165:20-13-2 is amended to correct a typographical error.

OAC 165:20-13-11 is amended to correct a typographical error.

OAC 165:20-15-1 is amended to update the reference to the Code of Federal Regulations to the most recent version.

OAC 165:20-17-6 is added as a new permanent rule requiring operators to provide additional information to excavators.

OAC 165:20-17-7 is added as a new permanent rule listing requirements for reporting damages.

OAC 165:20-17-8 is added as a new permanent rule requiring a written report of damages caused by excavation.

OAC 165:20-17-9 is added as a new permanent rule outlining the procedure for filing a complaint against an excavator for failing to comply with the Oklahoma Underground Facilities Damage Prevention Act.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Commission has authority to initiate this permanent rulemaking pursuant to the Oklahoma Administrative Procedures Act, 75 O.S. §§ 250 *et seq.*, 17 O.S. § 152, and Article IX, Section 18 of the Oklahoma Constitution.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that it is necessary to adopt permanent rules regarding Gas and Hazardous Liquid Pipeline Safety. Upon adoption of the permanent rules proposed herein, by the Commission, the proposed rules shall be submitted to the Governor and the Oklahoma Legislature for approval as permanent rules.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the proposed rules will be made available for public inspection at the Commission's Oklahoma City Court Clerk's Office, First Floor, Jim Thorpe Office Building, 2101 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, OK 73105. First Floor, Jim Thorpe Office Building, 2101 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, 73105, no later than fifteen (15) days after the date of publication of this Notice of Proposed Rulemaking.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Transportation Division will have **two (2) technical conferences on January 16, 2019 and February 5, 2019 at 1:30 p.m. in Courtroom 301**, Third Floor, Jim Thorpe Office Building, 2101 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. All parties interested in the proposed rules are urged and welcome to attend. One (1) or more of the Commissioners may be present at the technical conferences and may participate in the dialogue with the rulemaking participants regarding the issues of the proposed rulemaking.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Commission invites all interested persons to **submit comments regarding the proposed changes to the Rules on or before February 20, 2019**. Those persons interested in submitting comments should file one (1) copy of their comments, referring to Cause No. RM 201800020, with the Commission's Court Clerk's Office. The comments will be made available for public inspection by telephone, e-mail, or in-person request during regular business hours of the Court Clerk's Office, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.



NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at **9:30 a.m., February 27, 2019 in Courtroom 301** of the Jim Thorpe Office Building, 2101 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, the Commission shall meet, hold a public hearing on, and consider adoption of the proposed permanent rule(s).


